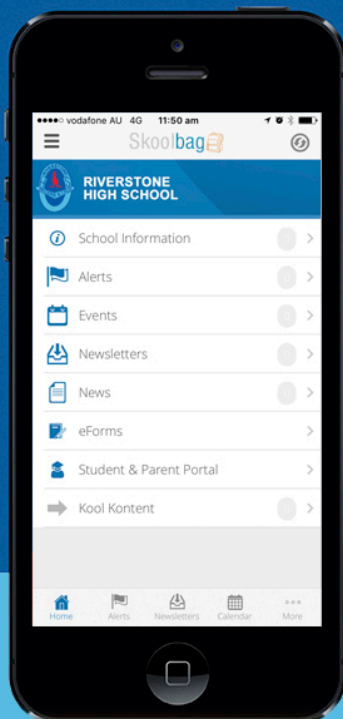
## DOWNLOAD OUR APP TODAY!
