

MAJOR CAPITAL WORKS PROJECT

The NSW Department of Education is undertaking a Major Capital Works project at Riverstone High School to provide additional future-focused learning spaces, refurbished administration facilities, refurbished student amenities and associated landscape works. We are pleased to advise Hansen Yuncken has been engaged to build the new facilities and the works have now commenced on site.

Construction works will be undertaken within a fully fenced off compound with separate entry to the school. Every effort will be made to minimise the impacts of construction works on the school.

A temporary administration has been established on Level 2 of Building A with directional signage and a new pathway has been installed to facilitate school access.

During the month of November, demolition of the existing administration and Building C will be completed. Once these demolition works are completed, construction of both the new learning building and administration will commence and continue throughout the upcoming summer holidays.

PARENT SESSION ELEVATE – STUDY SKILLS

Tuesday 4th December, 2018 9.00am – 10.00am Riverstone High School Library

This year, Riverstone High School students have been engaging with the Elevate Education – Study Skills seminars. These seminars have focused on teaching students how to study and prepare for assessments and examinations.

As part of our Year 7 Orientation Day, we are offering a free 1 hour workshop to any parent/carer to attend to learn about how to best support their child in achieving success in their education. This workshop is open to our entire parent community, including those parents/carers of Year 7 students 2019.

The session is 60 minutes long and is designed to be run as an open forum for discussion. This allows parents to ask our study skills experts any questions they have about being the parent of a secondary school student. Typical questions are:

- How do I help my child become more motivated
- How do I help my child improve their time management?
- •What work should my child be doing?
- How do I help my child deal with distractions?

The presenter then answers these questions by highlighting critical techniques from the Elevate seminars. For example:

- Creating realistic goals that actually work.
- Developing an effective study timetable that parents can help design.
- Providing parents with a road map of what work students should be doing and when.
- •Understanding the impact of distractions and the best ways to manage them.

The presenter will also stay after the session to answer any additional questions that the parents may have.
