

## **TELL THEM FROM ME – STUDENT & PARENT SURVEY**

This term, our school, like many other public schools in the state, will participate in a Department of Education initiative: the *Tell Them From Me* student feedback survey. The survey measures factors that are known to affect academic achievement and other student outcomes. The focus of the NSW-wide survey is on student wellbeing, engagement and effective teaching practices.

You may remember that our students also participated in a *Tell Them From Me* student survey in Term 1 this year. Asking students to complete the survey twice in one year allows the school to identify trends in student responses as well as track engagement and motivation across the school year.

The survey is a great opportunity for our students to provide the school with valuable and quick feedback on what they think about school life, how engaged they are with school and the different ways that teachers interact with them. More than 6,300 schools in Australia and around the world have used *Tell Them From Me* to survey, a total of 5.4 million students. Capturing the voices of our students will help improve how we do things at our school.

The survey is completely confidential. The survey is conducted online and will typically take less than 30 minutes to complete. It will be administered during school hours between 12 October and 23 October. Participating in the survey is entirely voluntary.

Parents will also have the opportunity to participate in the Partners in Learning parent survey, which is part of the *Tell Them From Me* suite of surveys on student engagement. The parent survey helps to clarify and strengthen the important relationship between parents and school. The survey is designed to measure, assess and report insights from the parent point of view at the school and system levels. Parents will be sent out a link to the survey via sms and will have until 23 October to complete the survey.

A consent form and FAQs for parents/carers about the survey is attached to the back of this newsletter.

#### SCHOOL UNIFORM



#### Tell Them From Me student survey: Information and consent form for parents and carers Centre for Education Statistics and Evaluation

**Dear Parents and Carers** 

This term, your school is taking part in the *Tell Them From Me* student survey. The survey will provide us with valuable feedback on what our students think about school life, how engaged they are with school and the different ways that teachers interact with them. Schools in Australia and around the world have used the *Tell Them From Me* survey to help them improve. The survey is completed on-line and is run by an independent research company, **The Learning Bar**, which specialises in school-based surveys.

Staff in schools will <u>not</u> be able to identify individual students from their responses. To ensure confidentiality, participating students will receive a unique username and password. Where fewer than five students respond to a question, the results will be suppressed. The survey typically takes 30 minutes or less to complete and will be administered by the school during normal school hours. Once the surveys are completed by students, reports are prepared and in most cases are available to schools within three business days.

This survey will help our school better understand how to improve student wellbeing and engagement. It will help the school identify what works to improve student outcomes.

Participating in the survey is entirely voluntary. Your child will not take part if either you or your child do not wish. If, during the survey, your child is uncomfortable, he/she can choose to stop the survey at any time. The majority of questions in the survey can be skipped.

If you <u>do not want</u> your child to take part in the survey, please complete the attached form and return it to your child's school by **Friday September 25 2020**.
